Costa Rica is home to 141 species of snakes. Despite the (undeserved) bad rap they get, most snakes aren't dangerous to humans. Only 23 of the 141 species in Costa Rica are dangerous to humans. And they are rarely a threat! I was thrilled to photograph a few of these 141 species this past month.
